About the Festival: The Claytor Lake Festival is an annual Celebration of Claytor Lake State Park providing visitors and participants with a fun filled *Family* day ending with fireworks on June 7, 2008. The festival, rain or shine, will include a Family Fun Festival including but not limited to arts and crafts sponsored by the Fine Arts Center for the New River Valley. We are very excited about this show and expect it to be profitable for exhibitors and vendors for years to come. Some special activities include the Fine Arts Center Wine Tasting and entertainment. Proceeds of the show will be used for art education through the Fine Art Center for the New River Valley.

Location: Claytor Lake State Park. Exit 101 off I-81 just outside of Dublin, Virginia. Camping is available through the Virginia State Park System; please reserve your camping spot as soon as possible by calling 1-800-933-7275. Comfort Inn of Dublin, located at exit 98 just off Interstate 81, has set aside a block of rooms for the Arts & Crafts participants at a discounted rate of \$55 plus tax **(offer good until May 25, 2008)**. To get the special rate, you must mention the Fine Arts Center. You may reserve your room by calling the Comfort Inn of Dublin at 540-674-1100.

Booth Spaces & Fees: single spaces are 10' X 10' pre-assigned and are available for exhibitor/vendors for \$75.00 per space and for food vendors \$150.00 per space. Additional 10' X 10' spaces are available for an additional \$75.00 or \$150.00 per space. Booths and guide wires must remain within your allotted space. Decorating your booth is encouraged. Due to limited electrical access, only food vendors will have electricity. The use of generators is strictly prohibited.

Exhibitor is solely responsible for any and all sales tax.

There is a gate fee of \$5.00 for parking; however, exhibitors will receive a complimentary parking pass.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Until Filled. Only thirty exhibitors will be accepted. Vendors will be notified immediately by mail when accepted. Your immediate response is requested.

- * Health Department application and \$40 fee payable to Pulaski County Health Department. All food vendors must comply with local Health Codes. The Fine Arts Center reserves the right to remove those vendors not in regulation.
- * **NOTE:** There are only *ten* spaces available; also, water will be available in the new conference center (no hose access) so **BRING CONTAINERS.**

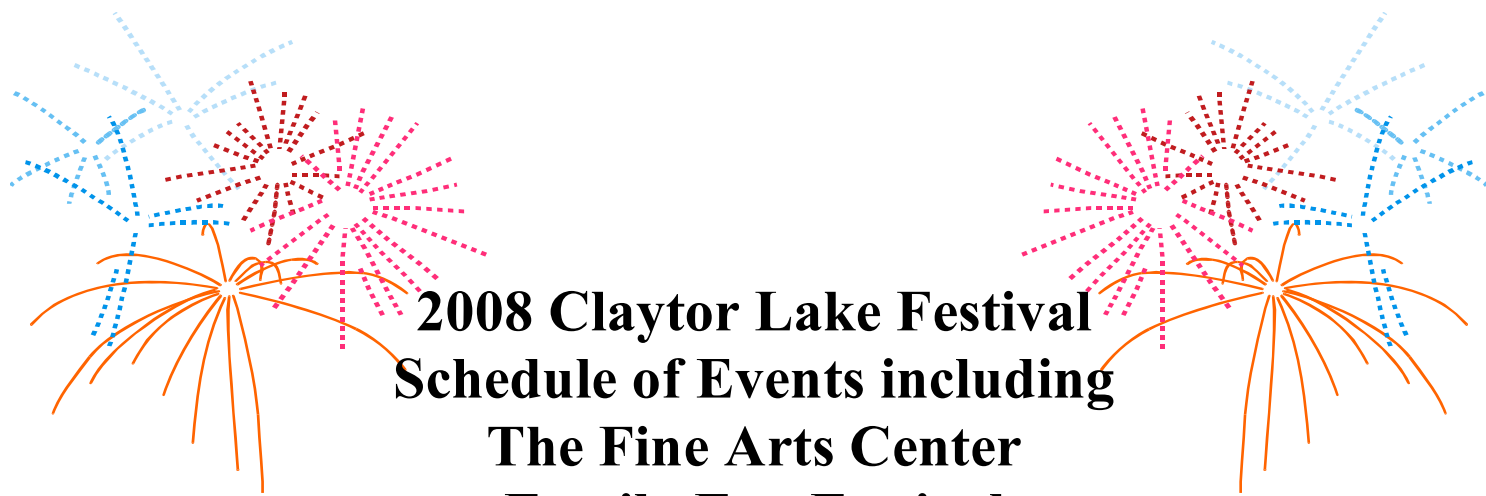
GUIDELINES

To ensure a level of quality, the following guidelines have been established.

1. All work must be owned by the exhibitor applying. No contract work will be accepted. The exhibitor applying must be present during all hours of the show. Each member's work must abide by these standards.
2. Arts/crafts must reflect quality craftsmanship. No flea market items accepted.
3. Work involving the reproduction of traditional designs should be faithful to the design.
4. Persons producing high quality work from currently available patterns (and kits) will be accepted for exhibit.
5. Commercially manufactured apparel or accessories (i.e. purchased jeans, aprons, smocks, t-shirts, etc.) with high quality handiwork or decorations added are allowed for exhibit and sale.
6. At no time during the show will sale signs, marked down prices, or anything that denotes price reduction be permitted.
7. Food vendors must comply with all state health food regulations. A copy of the New River Health District Temporary Food Event Packet and application is enclosed. Follow the guidelines and return to the Fine Arts Center.
8. We require that you set up for the entire scheduled event. You must notify us in writing in advance if you have a change in status, 48 hours prior to opening of Festival. Cancellation must be made 14 days before Festival to receive a full refund. No refunds or rollovers if cancelled within 72 hours. All fees must be paid at time of application. Aisles must be kept clear for the public. Exits must be kept clear per fire marshal. Early packing or departing from the Festival are not permitted. No packing until Festival has closed.

The festival committee, in the selection process, will use the preceding guidelines.

This Festival is intended for the family, planning completed by the Fine Arts Center reflects that purpose. Have a wonderful time!
